

# Macrons in Linux

Individual applications and individual distros may have other ways of inserting/creating macrons. This is a brief document to explain how RedHat distro will input UTF-8 macrons into applications. UTF-8 means that you do not need any special Maori fonts.

## ***Red Hat 8.\****

Select the Accessories folder/Character Map . From the Character map you can insert macrons.

## ***Open Office 1.\****

Select “Inset Special Characters” from the menu. The full range of macrons are in the options.
